Identity, history and description

Identity

13 Flowers / Smiling Tiger. The identity described here refers to the combination of name and breeder in the source, not to authentication of a physical sample.

Description

13 Flowers combines Mokum's Tulip with a G13 × Hash Plant male in the account reproduced by SeedFinder. Large trichome-covered flowers and a sweet character are reported, without more specific aromatic notes. [S1]

History and origin

Cross attributed to Smiling Tiger. [S1]

Recorded lineage

Mokum's Tulip × (G13 × Hash Plant) [S1]. Parentage attributed to the source, not independently validated genetics.
