Critical Bilbo is a clonal selection of Critical Mass associated with Bilbao. Historical accounts describe compact, resinous flowers and a sweet, fruity, intense aroma. The original clone and the Kritikal Bilbo seed line are distinct identities. [S1, S2, S3]

Identity, history and description

Attributions are separate from verified information. The material is not certified.

Identity

This record concerns Critical Bilbo as an elite clone, not a Kritikal Bilbo seed or any descendant of Critical Mass. "Elite Cut" retains the requested name, but does not establish the specimen's origin on its own. [S1, S2]

No chain of provenance has been supplied for the material. We therefore do not invent a supplier, mother-plant identifier or authenticity certificate. This record identifies the reference name; it does not authenticate a plant.

Description

Critical Bilbo is the name of a clonal selection of Critical Mass associated with Bilbao. Its recorded lineage leads to Afghan × Skunk #1 through Critical Mass: Bilbo identifies a selection within that family, not an additional cross. [S1, S2]

Historical accounts describe compact, resinous flowers accompanied by a sweet, fruity, intense aroma. This is the qualitative profile attributed to the clone in the sources consulted, not an observation or analysis of an HHH specimen. [S1, S3]

The clone's name should not be confused with Kritikal Bilbo, Genehtik's seed line. Shared genetic history does not make a seed the same cut. "Elite Cut" retains the requested name here without certifying provenance that has not been supplied. [S1, S2]

History and origin

The sources connect the clone to a Critical Mass selection in Bilbao. Attribution differs: the testimony reproduced by SeedFinder names César and Mikel; Genehtik's account credits David Merino. Both accounts remain visible rather than being resolved by assumption. [S1, S2]

Recorded lineage

Recorded lineage: Critical Bilbo, a selection of Critical Mass; Critical Mass, Afghan × Skunk #1. The connection to Critical Mass is a selection, not a new cross. This documentary outline does not authenticate the HHH specimen. [S1, S2]

Contradictory information stays marked. Figures are not filled in from similar names, and seed-line results are not transferred to a clone without evidence. Missing analysis does not establish that a compound is absent: it means no verifiable measurement is available here.

Sensory profile and documentation

Sensory profile

The references describe a sweet, fruity and intense aroma. These are qualitative descriptions associated with the historical name, not a tasting assessment or laboratory result for an HHH sample. [S1, S3]

The individual specimen's sensory description remains pending. No tasting scores, numerical intensity, guaranteed flavour or personal effects are assigned from an image or a name.

Terpenes

No sample-specific terpene panel is available. Myrcene, limonene and other compounds are not presented as measured or dominant. An aromatic impression is not chemical identification.

Any future report should be linked to its sample identifier, laboratory, date and results. Until then, this section explicitly contains no analytical data.

Documentary scope

Documentary scope: this dossier contains no instructions for cultivation, propagation or production and makes no promises about agronomic results. The images are artistic identities, not photographs of a documented growing cycle.

Documentary record

Minimum documentary record: exact name; declared provenance and its supporting document; receipt date; sample identifier; dated original photographs; laboratory references, if available; author and date of each revision. Keep facts, attributions and pending fields separate.
